Philadelphia. — Recruiting of men for police duty in France will be discontinued. The general staff of the American army has stopped all efforts in this direction in the United States.

Luxemburg. — With General Pershing, the American commander-in-chief, at her side, the youthful Grand-duchess of Luxemburg from the balcony of her palace, watched the American troops march into her capital to-day.

Great Lakes, Ill. — Officers at the Great Lakes Naval Training Station to-day estimated that between 5,000 and 8,000 men will be released from the station as the result of Secretary Daniels' order to accept requests for release from active service.

Washington. — The Senate committee, investigating brewery propaganda, decided to-day to take up on December 3, a general inquiry into German propaganda.

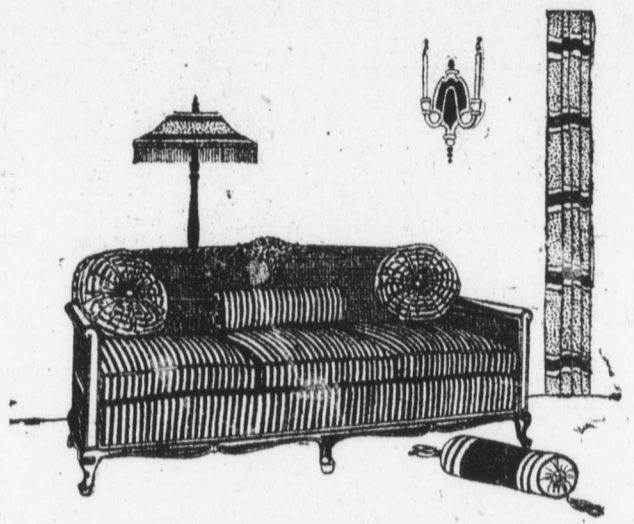

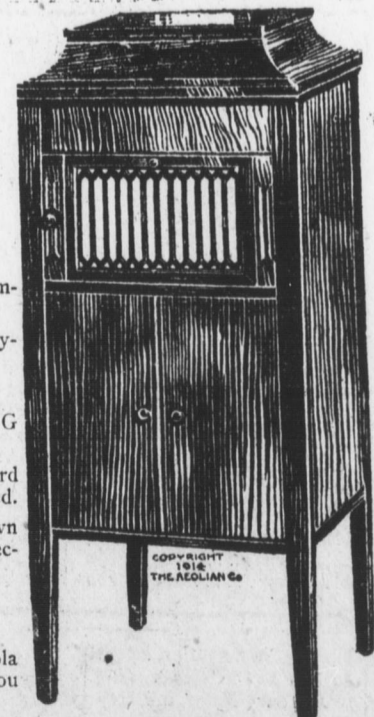
