

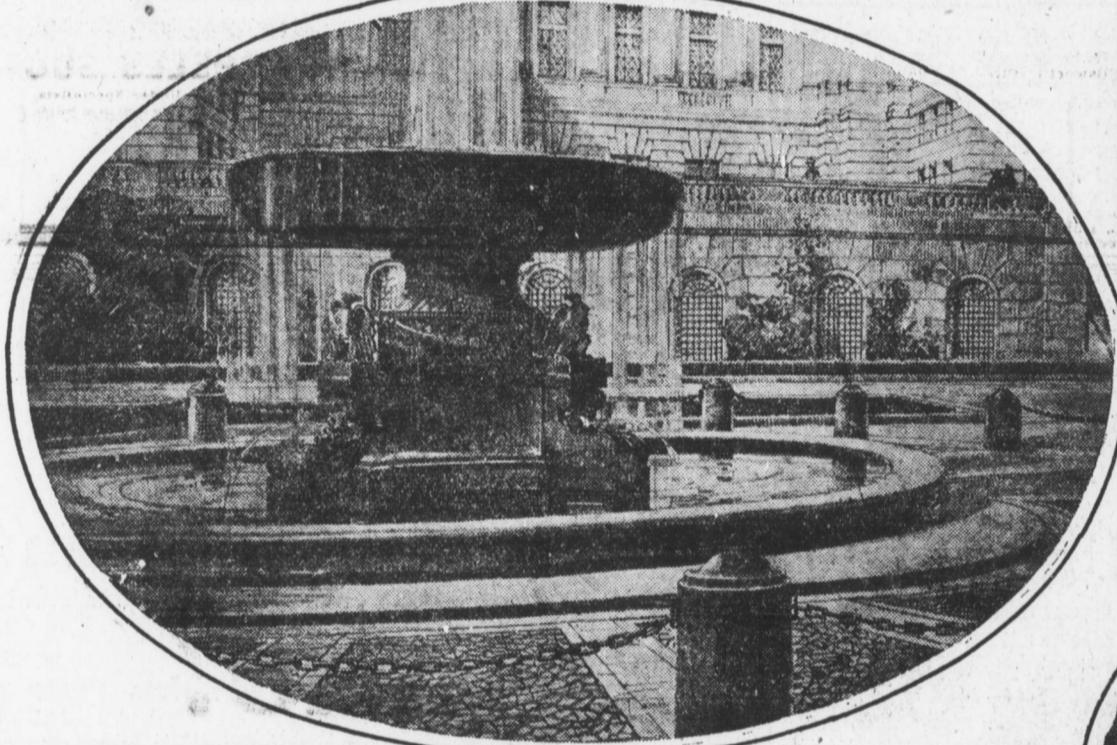

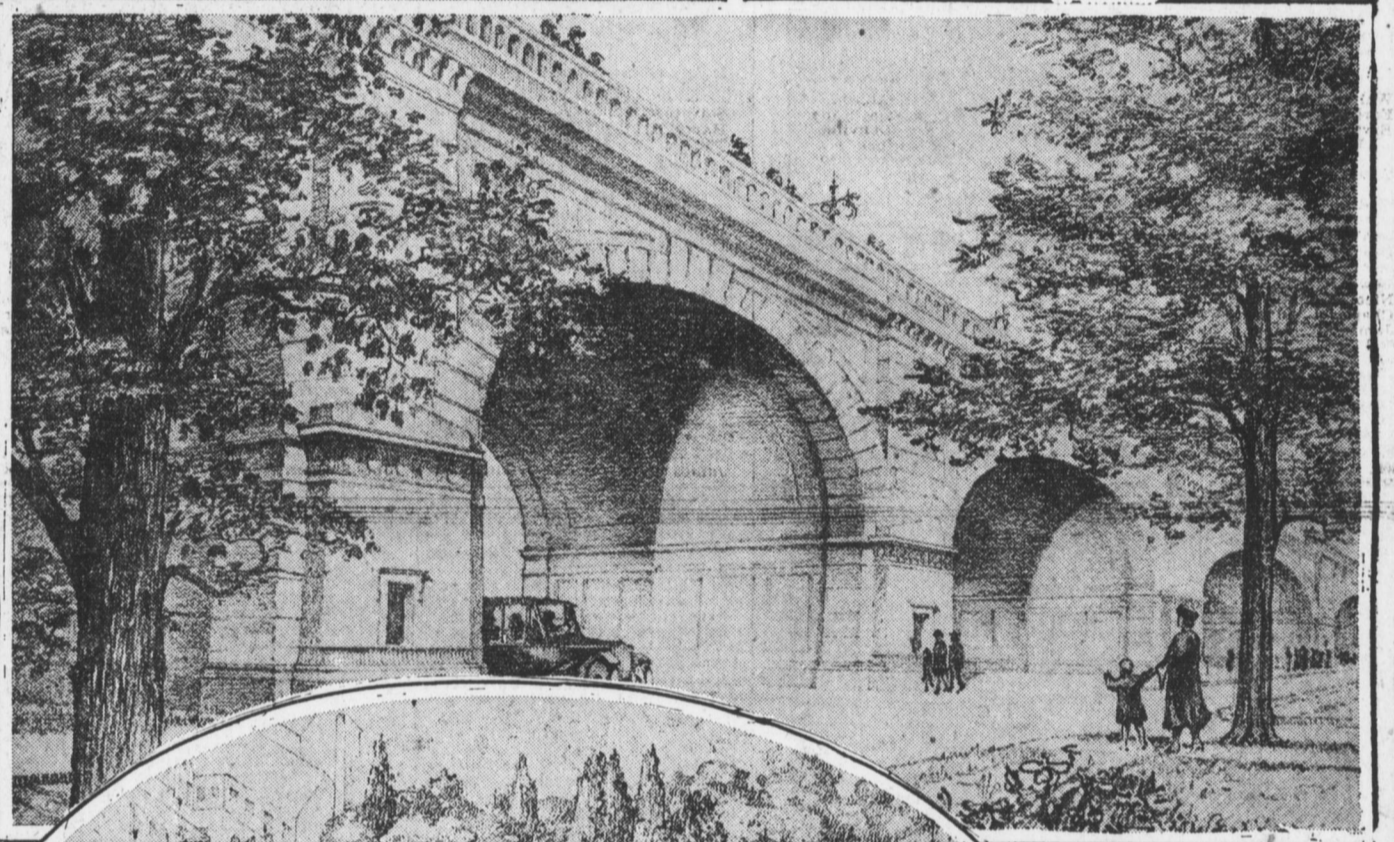
ARNOLD W. BRUNNER

NEW ENTRANCE TO THE MAIN BUILDING

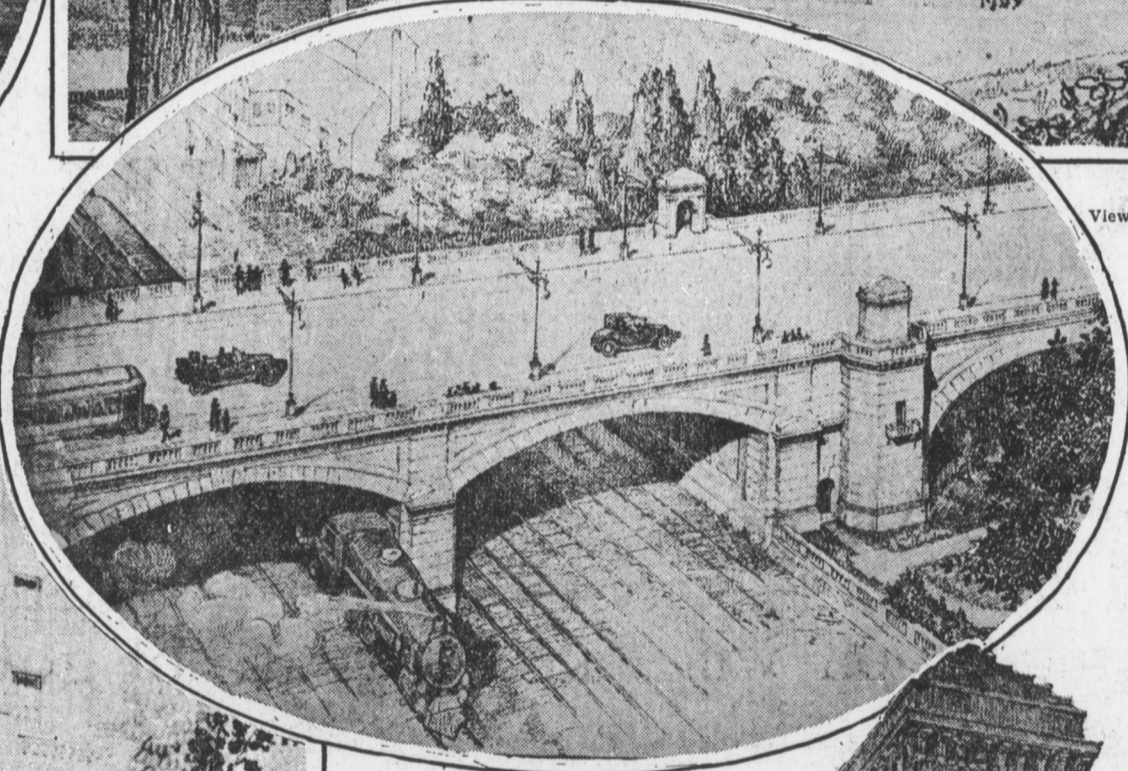

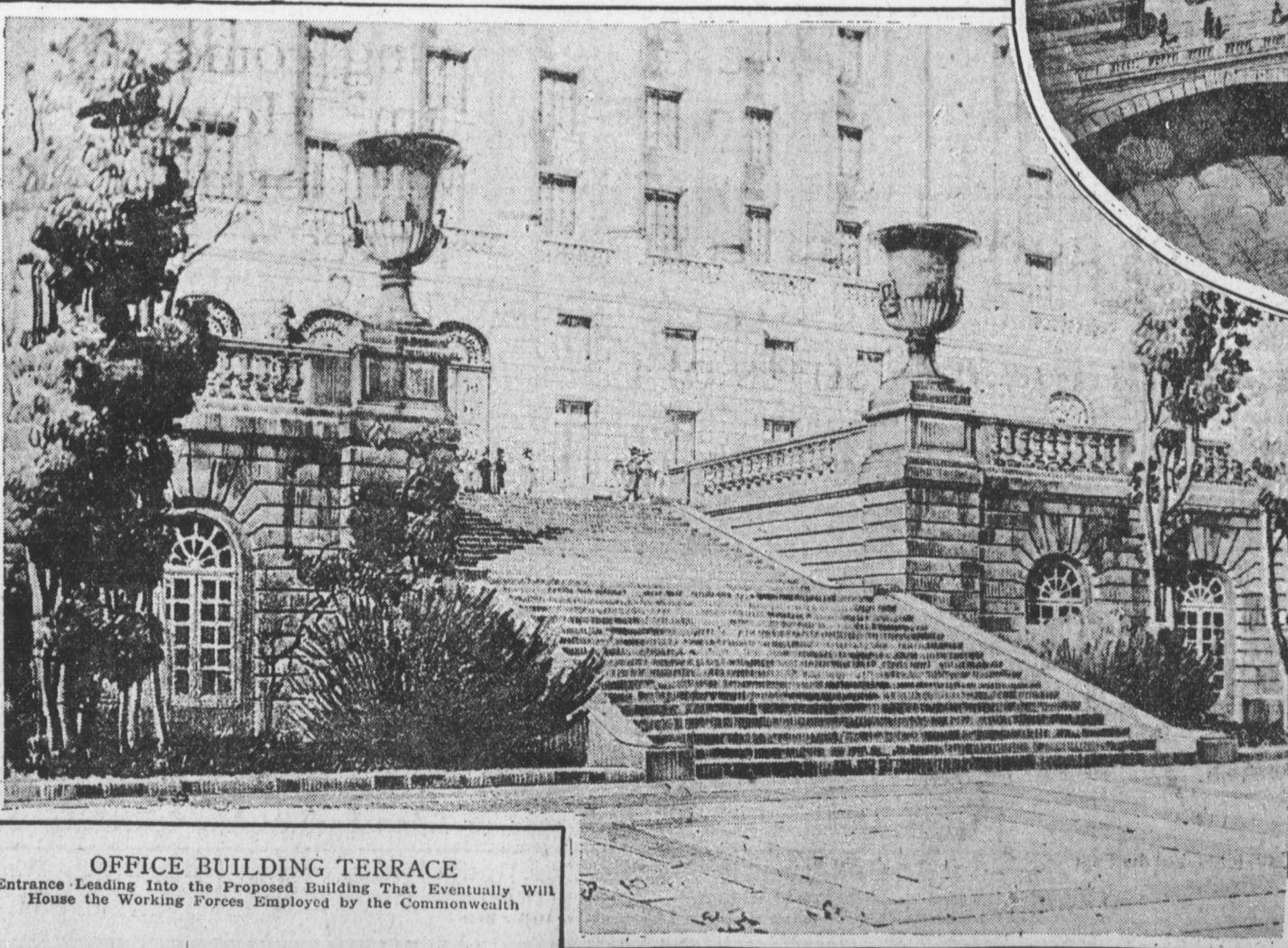
THE FOUNTAIN
