293 Yankees Fall in Action; 169 Die of Disease; 6,293 in Two Days' Casualties

Washington, Dec. 16.—The week-end casualties total 6,293, of these 3,722 were reported Sunday, and 2,571 to-day. Of the 293 reported in the combined lists as killed in action, 25 were Pennsylvanians. The summary for the two days' lists follows:
