

LARGER LISTS OF CASUALTIES ISSUED TODAY

Total of 747 Names Are Mentioned; Six Pennsylvania Men Killed in Action

Washington, Jan. 9.—To-day's casualty lists are heavier than they have been for several days, a total of 747 names being included on the two lists released to-day. Of these, 89 men were killed in action, of whom six were Pennsylvanians.

"I am going to keep a watch on your record there," said the Justice, "and if you behave yourself, I will help you start on a new career when you get out."
