

MUCH WORK IS DONE IN MONTH BY RED CROSS

Women Make Many Surgical Dressings and Refugee Garments

The Women's Bureau of the Harrisburg chapter, American Red Cross, produced during the past month a total of 8,068 articles, according to the report made public today by Miss Anne McCormick, director, and Mrs. G. H. Orth, executive secretary. In the same period more than 1,600 men were helped with information; more than 12,000 men were given meals and assistance by the canteen department; and 300 families were helped by the home service department. Thirty cases, a small box and three cartons containing 5,699 articles were shipped during the month. Articles were surgical dressings, hospital supplies, refugee garments, articles for soldiers, sweaters for Red Cross nurses and miscellaneous articles. A total of 11,462 articles were donated to canteens, the
