3,000 BRITISH MISSING

By Associated Press London, Feb. 26.—Replying to a question in the House of Commons last night Captain Frederick E. Gust, for the government, said the number of officers and men officially classed as war prisoners not yet been accounted for by the Germans approximated 3,000, including imperial and colonial troops and the

navy, but excluding the Indian troops.

CAMP LOGAN TO BE CLOSED By Associated Press Washington, Feb. 26.—Orders discontinuing Camp Logan, Texas, one of the points originally designated as demobilization centers, were announced to-day by the War Department. This makes sixteen camps to

be ordered closed since November 11.

SENATORS VOTE CONFIDENCE By Associated Press Paris, Feb. 26.—The French Senate to-day gave the government a vote of confidence by acclamation, following an address by Victor Boret, minister of provisions, during which he outlined the activities

of his department relative to meeting the high cost of living throughout the country.

WALLACE'S NAME GOES IN Washington, Feb. 26.—Hugh Campbell Wallace, of Tacoma, Wash., was nominated by President Wilson to be American Ambassador to France, to succeed Ambassador Sharp.
