Americans Lose 451 in North Russia Fighting Soviets; 252 Drown

Archangel, March 14.—As a result of the recent allied advance southward along the Murmansk railroad, part of another Russian province, Olonez, was added to the territory of the government of the north.

The American casualties from February 28 to March 9, inclusive, were five killed on the Vaga front and ten on the Dyva front. No officers were killed. One American soldier is missing and two officers and thirty men were wounded.
