Waynesboro Man Took Several at Hanover and Sold Them at Home Town

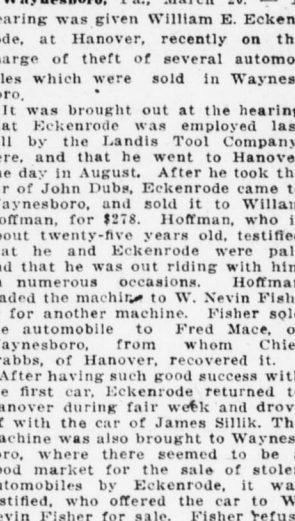
MANY TIMES ON CASUALTY LIST

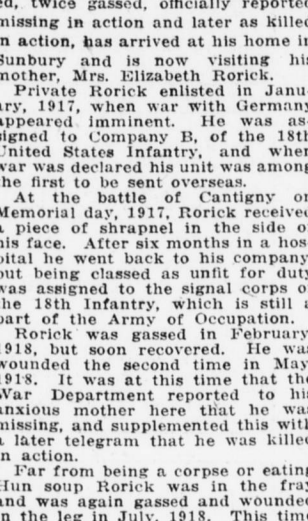
SUPPER FOR FRIENDS

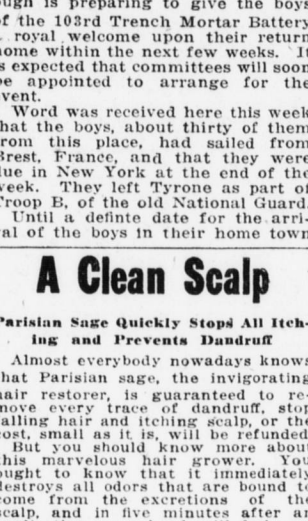
