New York, April 7.—To develop her railroads and industries, Poland is seeking to put into effect plans for "electrification" worked out "many years previous to the war" but blocked by "the economic policy of Russia, Germany and Austria," according to a statement issued here by the executive council of Polish societies in the United States.

In this statement, American capitalists are urged to construct large plants in the coal, oil and water power districts to transmit electric power to various industrial centers. They also are asked to establish factories for manufacture of standard electrical machinery and supplies.
