The reports coming to Harrisburg indicate that the trout have gotten through the winter vey well and that

the lack of ice and continuous 1 ow of water have made conditions most favorable.

The Leason will run from April 15 to August 1 and the limit is twenty-five trout a day. Some arrests have been made by fish wardens for fishing in advance of the season.

The State Commission of Fisheries at its meeting here this week approved the plans for construction work to be done at the various hatcheries and for the propagation work. Bids were also authorized for construction of a wooden tug for the department's work on Lake Erie.
