GOVERNMENT TO BACK BANKERS IN CHINESE LOANS

New Consortium Appears to Be Strong Enough to Get Federal Aid

Washington, May 13.—Organization of a new consortium for financing of Chinese loans, announced in Paris dispatches is regarded in official circles here as a triumph for the new American principle of extension of the scope of participation in international financial arrangements.

in international financial arrangements.

At the State Department it was said officially that under the conditions which are to govern the new consortium the government practically, if not in specific terms, guarantees the investments of the banking group interested.

If the terms of the loan are just and the conditions fair, and if China agrees to the terms under which the loans are made, it was stated officially that this government would assure the bankers, after the matter had been submitted to the State Department; that the United States would protect all the interests secured in good faith.

Thirty-seven American banks, it was learned, are interested in the loans that will be made to China by the international group. This is understood to have been one of the points contended for by the State Department after the United States withdrew—from the former—consortium which expires by limitation on next June 18. In the old consortium the American representation was limited to four large New York banks,


