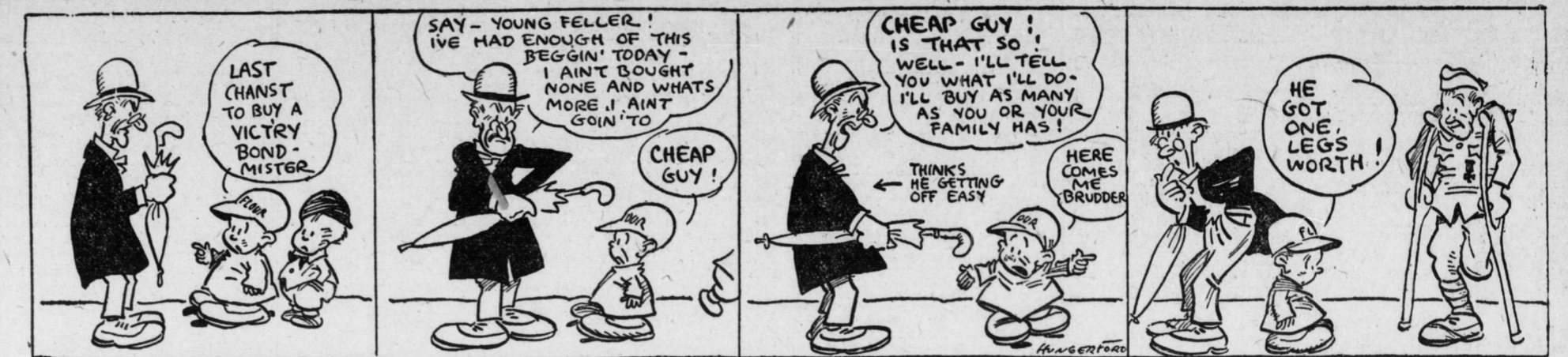

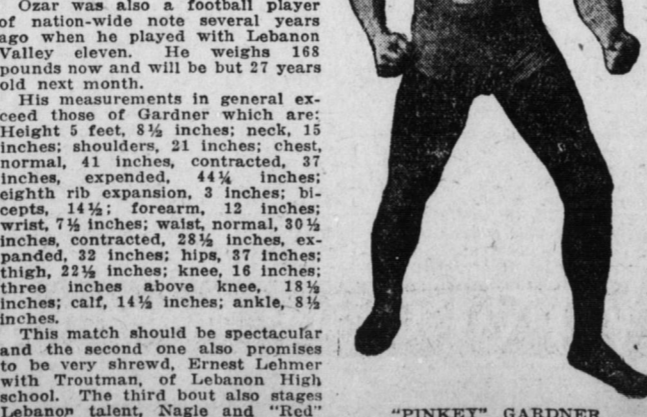

Low Tendler's Amazing Boxing Means Fortune

A line from Charley Ettinger, manager of Dundee, this morning says: 'The coming bout at Harrisburg next Saturday night between Allentown Dundee of this city and Lew Tendler, of Philadelphia, is the leading topic of discussion among the local sporting fraternity. Dundee, who has never had a decision rendered against him, meets the best man that he has ever been called upon to box. Local enthusiasts are confident that he will come up to their expectations.'

'Tendler fought when a newsboy around Philadelphia for anything he could get, until Lew Bailly, then manager of the Broadway club, gave him a battle for which Tendler got \$17.50. This sum was so large to Lew at the time, that he could hardly take time to put on his clothes after the battle, which he won, and took the money home to his mother for safe keeping. Tendler's hit with the fans and promoters was instantaneous, and his rise was rapid and below are some of the purses he received for six rounds in Philadelphia and other towns: For boxing Pasty Kline, at the National
