MARKETS RAILS LAG WHEN MARKET STARTS; STEEL ADVANCES

Oils and Shippings Share the Early Gains With Equipments; Lead Features

By Associated Press. New York, May 23. — Rails again proved the only exceptions to the higher trend at the opening of today's stock market, the usual leaders, especially oils and shippings, scoring early advances of 1 to 2 points with equipments.

Steel also rose a point and independent steels added to yesterday's gains. Metals were featured by National Lead, and motors and their subsidiaries rose 1 to 2 points. Shares of express companies, notably Adams and American, enhanced yesterday's gains by 1 to 5 points.
