Wilkes-Barre, Pa., June 11.—Former President William H. Taft delivered the principal oration at the graduation exercises of the Wilkes-Barre Institute for Young Women in this city last evening.

He declared that the proposed league "is the result of the demand of the people on the other side who won this war that there shall be as a result an assurance of future peace."

Mr. Taft declared that in the covenant there is no super-sovereignty and that the idea of a super-sovereignty was rejected for a number of reasons, among them the barrier raised by the American constitution.

MORE ELECTRICITY FOR ENGLAND IS PLAN OF NEW BILL

Measure Would Finally Provide Current For All Purposes

London, June 11.—England is preparing to provide herself with cheap and abundant electricity for heating, lighting and manufacturing purposes at an initial cost of approximately \$100,000,000.

The plan for placing the country over an electrical basis, provides for its division into districts, each district to be in charge of a commission.
