Third, there is very little export, as an insufficient number of snips are equipped with the proper efrigrenation for carrying great quantities of beef.

The price of corn fed cattle has undergone little or no change, and the retail dealers of this city are selling about five per cent of this kind of meat for the city's total consumption. The grass fed or medium grade cattle have decreased in price, but the retail dealers are selling this meat, which makes up 90 per cent of the total meat consumption of the city, at the same price as the higher grade of meat.
