Mitchell, a member of the State Senate from 1893 to 1901, who died at his home in Hamilton Saturday night, will be held there Tuesday afternoon, Mr. Mitchell, born in 1846, is survived by his widow and one daughter, Mrs. H. P. McCartney, of Altoona. He was a veteran of the Civil War.

Two Hun Prisoners Are Brought to U. S.

New York, July 21. - Two German prisoners of war, the first to be brought to the United States, arrived here to-day aboard the "Home" from Amagasaki, Japan. The identity of the prisoners, who are assigned to the director of military intelligence, was not made public.
