BROTHERHOODS PREPARED FOR RAILROAD STRIKE, RAILWAY AGE DECLARES

New York, Aug. 8. — That the leaders of the railroad labor brotherhoods "are fully prepared to call a general railroad strike for the purpose of forcing Government ownership and employes' management of the railroads upon the American people," is the opinion expressed by the Railway Age in an editorial in its current issue.

Three years ago the country was given an example of what Mr. Stone and his associates mean when they say "We will go far enough to win." Declining to submit their basic eight-hour day demand to arbitration in any form, the "Big Four" Brotherhoods frightened Congress into passing the Adamson Law by issuing an order for a tie-up of all the railroads of the United States and refusing to withdraw it until Congress passed the legislation that they wanted.

"Do the 110,000,000 people of the United States, of whom at least 80 per cent. are opposed to Government ownership and favor a return of the railroads to the private companies, intend to let the labor leaders, by threatening or calling strikes, force the tax paying public to buy the railroads and assume complete responsibility for their financial results, and then force the public to turn the railroads over to the employees to manage?"

HOOVER STOPS RELIEF SUPPLIES TO RUMANIANS

No American Troops in Budapest and None to Go There

Paris, Aug. 8.—Herbert Hoover, head of the Inter-Allied Relief Commission, has stopped all relief supplies on the way to Budapest, citing the position that he would be unwarranted in letting supplies reach Hungary while the Rumanians are depriving the people of foodstuffs.
