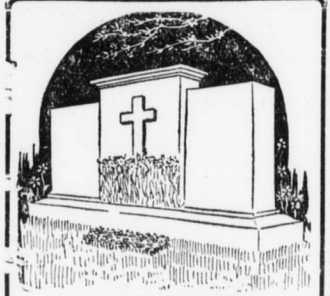


Foresees Repeal of Wartime Booze Laws in Less Than Month

107,000 Pounds of Food Wasted in Philadelphia in Effort to Keep Prices Up

John S. Miller, 162 South Second street, who has been recovering from a year's illness, was knocked down by a boy playing baseball and badly bruised.

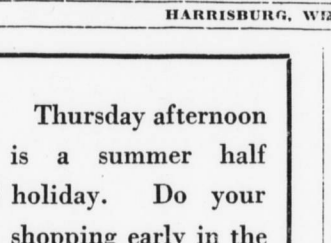
