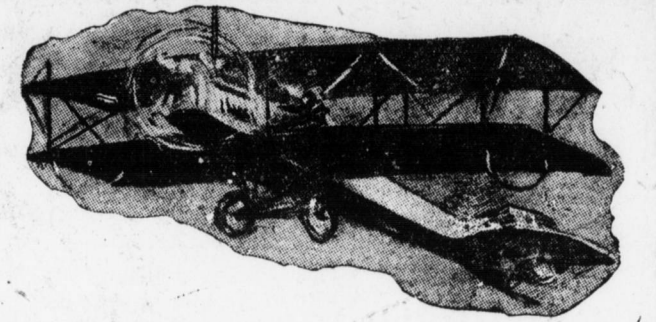

LARGE FIELD--25 ACRES--HANGARS--REPAIR SHOPS--GRANDSTANDS--EVERYTHING

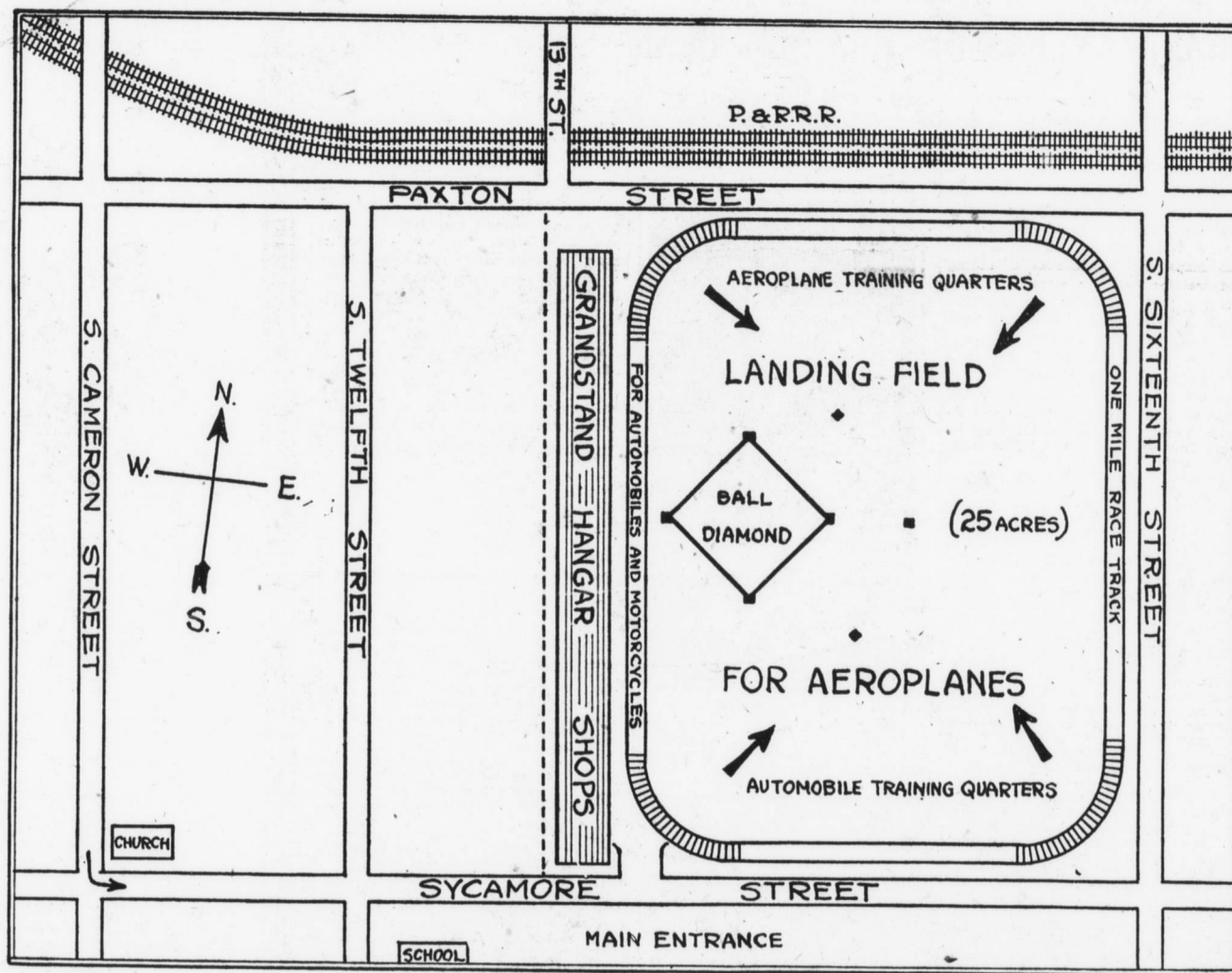
Harrisburg is to have an Aeroplane Landing Field at last. A 25-acre field has been leased by the Automobile and Aeroplane Mechanical School and will be leveled off and made into a first-class aero field, the same as in other large cities. This large field is in South Harrisburg, just below the Philadelphia and Reading railroad. Sycamore street is on the south, Paxton street on the north, Thirteenth street on the west and Sixteenth street on the east.

A one-mile racetrack for automobiles and motorcycles will be an added feature of this big field. Races will be held there and the track will be used to

test machines. A first-class baseball diamond will also be added. Large grandstands will be erected. Underneath the stands will be the shops and hangars. Everything will be first class and up to date. The Automobile and Aeroplane School will conduct their classes in these large shops. Aviators will be trained on the field. Passengers will be given exhibition flights from there.

A main entrance to the field will be on Sycamore street, just east of Twelfth. Work will be started on this new field next week. As soon as the hangars are ready, the aeroplanes of the school will be put in active operation.
