"This is a ridiculous, vicious, class legislation," Felin continued. "It will put us under the domination of bureau employees. It will hurt us smaller fellows because no bank is likely to take the paper of concerns

whose doors are likely to be closed any minute at the whim of individual officials."

killed by Mexicans at Compa, in the State of Chihuahua, August 30, according to advice received by the State Department. Representations have been made to the Mexican Government and instructions issued for an immediate and careful inquiry into the facts of McGill's death. McGill, riding horseback, was attacked from ambush. He was shot

from his horse, beaten to death and his body thrown in the Coupa river.
