Negroes Endorse Lynching of One of Their Own Race

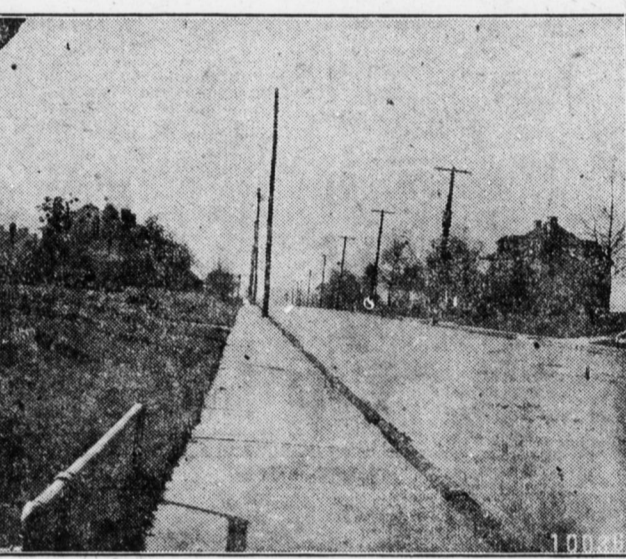
