GREAT SCHOOL BUILDING AHEAD

Dr. Finegan Says That Greatest Construction Year in School History Is Due



As the result of a study of prices for school house building materials after the Civil War and at present necessitated by the unusual number of plans for new construction of schools being submitted to the Department of Public Instruction, Dr. Thomas E. Finegan, the new State Superintendent, says that he feels justified in assuring school boards and school officials generally that where additional school housing accommodations are necessary in order not to interfere with the work of the schools or not to delay the progressive educational activities of a school district, the new building should not be delayed on account of prevailing prices. Studies of prices and conditions have led to the conclusion that present prices will in all probability continue to dominate the situation indefinitely.
