

Increase in Jewelry Exports to Europe Will Reach Millions

Chicago, Nov. 13. — The export business in jewelry from the United States to Europe, according to the

president of a large jewelry firm here, will show an increase of several million dollars during the next year. "The United States," he said, "has secured the service of approximately 90 per cent of the expert gold and silver workers of the world who were engaged in the business prior to the war. Virtually the entire

world is dependent on these men now working in American shops and factories for what is technically known as oriental jewelry. "Among the artificers who have come to America are the cleverest of the workmen who formerly made antique mountings in Europe. Today the European dealer is confronted with a condition the Ameri-

can dealer faced before the war. To get his original mountings, he has to send to the United States. Before the war, it was the other way around. Most of these expert workmen came from the Netherlands, Belgium, Bulgaria, Switzerland and France." Use McNeil's Cold Tablets. — Adv.

Engineers Discover Original Niagara

Niagara marking the course of a paleolithic river that connected Lake Erie and Lake Ontario. Some mighty prehistoric cataclysm, it is supposed, diverted the course of the stream and buried the falls and the old river bed level with the surrounding country.
