BACKENSTOSS TO DEVOTE ENTIRE TIME TO REALTY

Mayor's Secretary, Who Quits Office in January, Served Four Administrations

After having served under four city executives, Clarence O. Backenstoss will retire as secretary to Mayor Kestler when the present administration ends on January 6.

Camden Is Shaken by Gas Explosion

Camden, N. J., Nov. 20.—North Camden was shaken and scores of windows broken early to-day when two gas tanks exploded at the plant of the Delaware Shipbuilding and Repair Company.

The tanks were in the main building, which was destroyed. The explosion is believed to have resulted from a fire started by sparks from the old system.
