Washington, Nov. 22. — Cotton ginned to November 1 from the 1919 crop totalled 7,577,826 runing bales, counting round bales as half bales, the Census Bureau announced today. For a corresponding period of 1918 the total was 8,706,420 bales. Round bales totalled 83,643; American-Egyptian, 17,067, and Sea Island, 4,226 bales.
