MORE PAY FOR NAVY MEN

Washington, Nov. 26.—Pay increase for officers and men of the navy will be recommended to Congress by the House Naval Committee soon after the opening of the regular session next week, representative Killy, Republican, Michigan, subcommittee chairman, started today. Except for recruits whose pay is \$33 a month, increases would be general under a plan approved by the subcommittee.

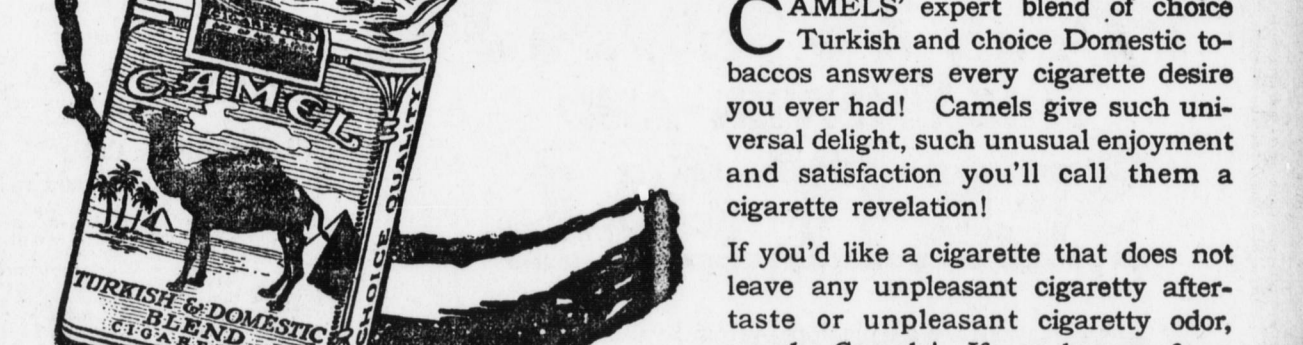
