

Action of U. S. Senate Aids and Hurts Berlin

Berlin, Nov. 24 (Delayed).—Even if the American Senate eventually ratifies the Peace Treaty, the En-

ente must figure that the United States has assumed a position against mixing in "purely European affairs," Theodore Wolf declared in an article in the Tageblatt to-day.

Germany should receive the Senate's recent refusal to ratify the Treaty with "mixed feelings," Wolf said. It is partly an advantage and partly a disadvantage to her, the writer said, adding that the refusal cannot be taken as a "ground for pure joy alone."

The recent refusal of the Senate to ratify the Versailles pact "must have convinced the Entente that American blood, shed in common with theirs, has not proved a durable cement for every occasion or that the Entente can absolutely count upon America's help in disentangling European chaos," the German editor asserted.

American aid in protecting the "fantastical structure" erected by the Peace Conference is by no means assured, the writer maintained, declaring that any guarantees of aid the United States may give the Allies cannot be depended upon to apply in all cases, particularly where purely European affairs are involved.

JESSE METCALF IS SUED BY GIRL FOR \$100,000 New York, Nov. 26.—Jesse Metcalf, woolen merchant and clubman, has been named defendant in a \$100,000 breach of promise suit brought by Miss Beverly Juneau. The papers in the action were filed in the Supreme Court by the plaintiffs' at-

torney, Frederick M. Harris, of 90 West Broadway. Miss Juneau, whose address is not given, alleged Mr. Metcalf promised to marry her in September, 1918, and represented himself as a single man. She gave her consent, she says, but later learned Mr. Metcalf was married.
