Fisher Comments on the Fiduciaries

In his review of the business of the State Banking Department for 1918, the year before he assumed office, State Banking Commissioner John S. Fisher has this to say about fiduciaries:

"One of the effects of the Federal Law has been to lead a number of the states, including our own Commonwealth, to grant fiduciary powers to State banks. Both National and State banks possess only a limited charter existence. I am firmly convinced that no corporation should act as a fiduciary unless it possesses a perpetual charter."
