FROM, and LOSS OF SAW LOGS—On Friday afternoon the northern counties of the central part of this State were visited with a most terrible storm of rain.

Pine creek was higher than it has been known for many years, and the Chemung, Tioga, Sinnemahoning, Kettle Creek and other streams in this section of the State were raised to a very unusual freshet.

Pine creek raked about nine feet in three hours and committed great destruction to roads, bridges, farms and lumbering establishments. The Booms near the mouth of the Creek were broken and a vast quantity of logs escaped.

The Booms were undergoing repairs, and was closed until after daylight. Some of the logs that were rafted out for some of the mills below broke loose about two o'clock in the morning, and they continued to break their fastenings until after six o'clock, when the Booms and other fastenings were secured.

About three millions of feet escaped from the Jaysburg, Williamsport and Loyalsock mills. The fastenings of the Lock Haven Boom gave way, where they had been rafting out, and nearly the entire stock escaped, amounting in all to about 15,000,000 feet.

About 6,000,000 feet escaped from the Pine creek Booms. Many of these logs were caught in the Boom at Williamsport, how many, we are unable at this time to determine.

The logs commenced to pass Williamsport about two o'clock in the morning, and at times in large quantities until the Boom succeeded in stopping them.

The river at Williamsport at its highest point was twelve feet above low water—Williamsport Bulletin.

An Irishman, named Thomas Kelly, for some time past a resident of Williamsport, and who was reported to have been killed on the rail road near the Nancy Station, by the Sunbury & Erie train going south, on Monday evening of last week, it is now believed was dead before the train struck him.

When last seen alive he was very much intoxicated.—Munday Lumberer.

On the 6th inst., John Cathcart was lodged in the Clearfield county Jail, charged with having shot his wife, on the Saturday previous. The ball entered her breast, and lodged in the backbone. She survived six hours.

The St. Louis Democrat learns that the steamer Lucas, from Memphis, encountered a fifteen minute snow storm on Sunday morning, the 12th inst.

Calab C. Woodbury, Postmaster at White Pigeon, who was recently arrested for robbing the mail, committed suicide on the 19th inst., preferring death to imprisonment.

A heavy thunder storm visited Philadelphia, on the 12th inst., and owing to the great quantity of water that fell, the sewers were too small to carry it off, and in consequence the streets and pavements were overflowed and cellars were filled, resulting in great damage to property.

At several points culverts fell in carrying with them the railroad tracks, and causing great alarm to the resident occupants of houses in the vicinity.
