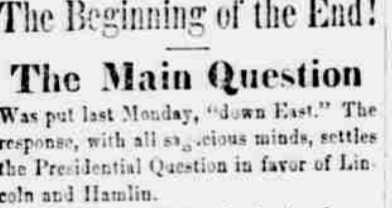

To make Pure Wine.
[The best, richest, and least stimulating "juice of the grape," we ever tasted, was made by a gentleman in the lower end of Lycoming county, as indicated below.

Dear Sir: By your request, I give my method of making wine on a small scale.
Have your grapes free from all impurities, such as stems, unripe, &c.; wash the grapes with a wooden stamper in strong earthen or stone-ware crocks; empty the mass into hard burnt earthen or stone-ware crocks, (I prefer the latter), adding two-and-a-half pounds of good white sugar to every gallon of mashed grapes;
