The Union Divided!

History will mark James Buchanan's Administration for three events--the bankruptcy of a full Treasury in time of peace and bounteous harvests--the division and demoralizing of the Democratic party--and the Division of the National Union, as far as a State could accomplish it.

THE NATIONAL CABINET.--We do not lumber our columns with the thousands of guesses and conjectures set afloat respecting the course of the in-coming Administration. But it is announced as certain that EDWARD BATES, of Missouri, has been offered and accepted a seat as one of the confidential advisers and agents of President Lincoln--probably as Secretary of the Interior. His name is everywhere received as evidence that the President will pursue a truly national and conservative course in all respects.

Gen. Cameron or Judge Wilmore are named as most likely to represent the Republican Banner State in the Cabinet. Both are capable men, and have legions of most ardent friends. The latter has said Mr. Lincoln, upon invitation, a visit.

The President elect receives visitors of every faith, reads all communications as far as possible, and evinces to all the qualities that constitute an affable, popular, faithful, successful Executive.

It is stated in various quarters that Gov. CURTIN has made his principal appointments, as follows: Secretary of the Commonwealth--Eli Sifer, of Union county.

Deputy--John M. Sullivan, of Butler. Attorney General--Samuel A. Purviance, of Beaver.

Message--S. D. Miles, of Centre. Mr. Sullivan has been already tried, and no one doubts his superior qualifications and integrity. Mr. Sifer has the confidence of his many acquaintances in varied political stations, of all parties throughout the State. Mr. Purviance is an honored and eminent lawyer, of the highest character and ability. Mr. Miles is an industrious and worthy mechanic of Milesburg. To most, if not all of these gentlemen, the stations were offered by Gov. Curtin without any effort or solicitation on their part. Their selection is creditable to the judgment of the State Executive, and will go far to command public confidence.

The "Secession" Act.

In the South Carolina Convention, Dec. 20, the following was proposed: An Ordinance to Dissolve the Union between the State of South Carolina and other States united with her under the compact entitled the Constitution of the U. S. of America: We the People of the State of South Carolina, in Convention do declare and ordain, and it is hereby declared and ordained, that the Ordinance, adopted by us in Convention on the 23d day of May, A. D. 1788, whereby the Constitution of the United States was ratified, and also all acts and parts of acts of the General Assembly of this State ratifying the amendments of the said Constitution, are hereby repealed; and that the Union now subsisting between South Carolina and the other States, under the name of the United States of America, is hereby dissolved.

The ordinance was taken up and passed by a unanimous vote of 169--nobody being allowed to be elected except Secessionists. Mr. Miles moved that the Clerk telegraph to the members of Congress at Washington, immediately.

Mr. McGrath said: To my understanding, there is no Collector of the port, nor Postmaster, now within the limits of South Carolina. What you have done today, has extinguished the authority of every man in South Carolina deriving his authority from the General Government.

Mr. Gregg said: After South Carolina has abrogated the Constitution of the United States, are its laws still of force? I think not. All the laws of Congress fall instantly to the ground on the act of secession. There is now no law on the subject of the collection of duties in South Carolina, NOW THAT WE HAVE ACCOMPLISHED THE WORK OF FORTY YEARS.

Mr. Hayne. This sudden action is injurious. Mr. Chesnut. Two questions are involved--our power and our duty. We must preserve our people, not only from inconvenience but a chaotic condition. We must verify such laws as will best preserve us from calamities.

Mr. Calhoun. We have pulled the quarter down that had been built three quarters of a century. We must clear the rubbish away, and reconstruct another. It is now homeless and houseless, and must secure ourselves from storms.

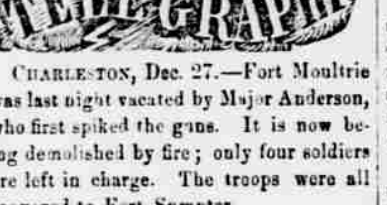
Mr. Dunkin. If the ordinance be ratified, things will go on in the Custom House, and Post Office, exactly as now, until other arrangements are made by this Convention. What is a legal tender for the payment of debts? Is it now the gold and silver of the United States? In case of the clearing and entry of vessels, we will be very liable to have the same confiscated.

Mr. Rhett. The great revolution must go on with as little danger as possible to the country, by making the Federal agents our machinery.

CHARLESTON, Dec. 27.--Fort Moultrie was last night vacated by Major Anderson, who first spiked the guns. It is now being demolished by fire; only four soldiers are left in charge. The troops were all conveyed to Fort Sumpter.

This announcement has created intense excitement, and the Convention is now in secret session.

STILL LATER.--Noon. Latest reports are that it is only the gun carriages that are on fire--it is certain that the guns are spiked, and reported that a train has been led to blow up the Fort.

LATER, 4 past 12.--Major Anderson stated that he evacuated Fort Moultrie in order to ally the discussion about that post and at the same time to strengthen his own position.

I. P. M.--Capt. Foster remains with a small force at Ft. Moultrie. Several military companies of the City have been ordered out, and a collision is not improbable.

In the Convention, Mr. Detreville offered a resolution that the Governor of S. C. be authorized and required to take immediate possession of Forts Moultrie and Sumpter, when he was informed that a motion for a secret session had the precedence--and the Convention went into secret session.

YONK CHARGE.--The National Treasury has been robbed of a sum, estimated between \$500,000 and \$3,000,000. They were securities for Indian payments. A South Carolinian, named Bailey, gave them to one of the notorious Kansas and Utah contractors, Messrs. Russell & Waddell, who used them in their speculations, promising to replace them. John B. Floyd, Secretary at War, is badly implicated in the transaction. Bailey and Russell are under arrest, and it is hoped the securities may (some or all) be identified and recovered. It looks to many as an attempt to rob the Treasury outright, as well as to dissolve the Union.

Jacob Thompson, Secretary of the Interior, recently left his post to go to North Carolina and preach Disunion as the Agent of Mississippi. Why does not Buchanan turn out and punish such traitors, instead of calling upon honest people to pray for them? "Put your shoulders to the wheel, and not call upon Jove," was a fable of old, applicable to our weak President.

We see intimations of "Wide Awakes," as such, attending the inauguration of Gov. Curtin and Pres. Lincoln. We believe it is the custom--and a very proper custom, too--when the contest is decided, to inaugurate those officers as representatives of the whole People, and not of a Party. We think it would tend to allay excitement and prejudice, and increase the interest and number of spectators, to make them general and not particular observances. We doubt not Gov. Packer would be as polite to his successor, as Gov. Pollock was to him.

Friday of next week is the day recommended by Pres. Buchanan for National Humiliation, Fasting and Prayer. The terms of the request are unquestionable, and the means to seek the end desired proper at all times. But we do not see that those who are creating the disturbance, and threatening the Union, or affording "aid and comfort" to them, pay any heed to this advice. And the thought must arise with all, that if the President had acted justly with Kansas, had discarded the traitors to his country and to their oaths who he put and kept in posts of power to do the mischief, or if he would not manfully perform his duty and protect the public property, the danger would be averted.--The 8th chapter of Isaiah is worthy of consultation in connection with the general subject.

Benj. F. Wade, of Ohio, a Republican, and Andrew Johnson, of Tenn., a Democrat, have made speeches in the U. S. Senate, against the Secessionists, full of the most powerful logic and patriotic devotion to the Union of our fathers. With all its faults and difficulties, it is better than anarchy or a multiplicity of little nations.

The Kansas Admission Bill is to be taken up in Congress, Monday next.

The House passed a Pacific Railroad Bill, and one or two small appropriations.

Gen. Scott expresses himself emphatically in favor of preserving the Union, by defending the fortifications, and by insuring the inauguration of Lincoln, to take command.

Some of the South Carolinians tore off their cockades, in anger, when the Seceders returned from fear of a little skirmish, and hastened away to Charleston from their Capital.

Postmaster General Holt has adopted a short and sensible policy toward the few disunion postmasters who propose to resign their offices. He informs them that if they name successors who will give the usual securities to the Department, they will be accepted, and business permitted to go on as before. Otherwise, the offices will be discontinued.

Of 781 patriotic, fire-eating South Carolinians drawing money from the United States, only nine have resigned--and these resignations only take effect at the expiration of Buchanan's term!

The Georgia Senate voted--56 to 51--against "separate secession."

A prominent Democrat of Kentucky said the other day: "If we of the South were to read Henry Clay's last speech at Lexington, without knowing the author, it would be very generally ascribed to Seward or Wilson."

The whole number of Post Offices in the United States is 28,573. What a sempering there soon will be of Post Masters!

Louisiana's chief occupation is raising sugar. Her industry and commerce are mainly based on it. Sugar is now protected by a duty of 24 per cent. against the competition of the West Indies. But if she secedes and joins a Southern Confederacy, one of whose maxims is "Free Trade," half her plantations would go to waste and half her planters to ruin.

Mrs. Anderson, wife of the commander at Fort Moultrie, called upon the President, and assured him that his neglect to reinforce the Fort would be an intentional and wicked sacrifice of her husband's life, as he would never surrender, but fall in defence of his post.

Mr. Buchanan is terribly agitated and some profane to see in him indications of insanity.

Senator Tombs has come again to Washington, but not "with his sword drawn and an army of ten thousand men," as he threatened before Lincoln's election.

Ex-Gov. Wise, it is stated, now recommends raising men in Virginia and Maryland to take Washington and inaugurate Breckinridge as Autocrat of the Southern Confederacy on the 1st March. He was "going" to do the same thing with Fremont. John Brown attempted to take a smaller town, but failed most awfully--let Wise take warning.

The Emperor of Russia is progressing with the emancipation of her serfs. All the world is becoming free and more civilized, except a portion of the American Union, which seems sinking into anarchy and the rule of mere brute force.

Six millions of dollars in gold were received in New York last week. Despite the desperate efforts of the Slave Politicians' Panic, times are improving in many quarters in the North, East and West, while the South is bent on suicide and injuring her own credit and resources to a great and alarming extent.

Pres. Lincoln will journey in Washington, with Senator Trumbull, prior to entering into the White House.

The Methodistists expect to open a new house of worship, in Green Valley, 2 1/2 miles north-east of Hughesville, Sunday, 6th of January next.

The Lyeomg Insurance Company paid \$12,000 for losses by fire, during the three months ending 10th. Nov. last.

Dr. Raper and family, at Lairdville, whose illness from using apple-butter put up in earthen crocks, are getting better. We have been informed that a number of persons in Columbia county, have been suffering in the same manner and from the same cause.

The act authorizing the construction of the road from the Junction to Sunbury or Northumberland, on the west side of the Susquehanna, was passed last winter and signed a week or two since by the Governor.
