**PERSEVERE FIGHT**—On the 11th inst., Col. Sargent, U. S. Army, with 1000 men, encountered the Rebels, in the Orange Valley, South Western Missouri, a list of Rebels, variously estimated at from 6000 to 10000. Sargent's army charged upon the enemy, and drove them back, finally repulsed, and retired to good order, farther north. The Rebels were pushing forward on both sides, and both sides will be the result.

Col. Wolf, (Union), was killed in an engagement near Springfield. Some Rebels were killed in these various encounters on the 11th, but it is believed the Rebel loss is greater.

**CINCINNATI, July 11**—There was a battle fought at Laurel Hill, in Western Virginia, yesterday afternoon, when a Union Regiment, 1200 strong, were defeated, their captives carried off, and sent in part of prisoners. Our loss is 1000 men, and 1000 wounded—the Rebels' loss is 1000 men.

Wm. Wier, who was wounded some days ago, is reported dead. The Rebels' number of troops are estimated at 10000.

The General Government having recognized the new constitution of Virginia in its Legislature is now in session at Wheeling. Gen. Polk has issued a report on a Western Bank of 257,000 of State money which Wier was at. The Rebels' Government are favoring the new constitution against the People's organization, because the old one is better.
