

Worse than Highway Robbery.

Who steals your purse, steals your money... There seems to be a combination in certain quarters to rob the names of Lyon, Butler, Rosecrans, Lander, Seigel, Grant, Curtis, Garfield, Burnside, Fremont, Smith, Banks, Geary, Wallace, and other Army officers and privates--and of Dupont, Goldsborough, Rowan, Foote, Worden, Rogers, Morris, and other Naval officers and sailors--of all the credit due them for deeds of valor in the service of their country during this war, and to bestow the laurels they have won upon their superiors in rank only. Thus, Halleck--who never fought a battle--is credited with the victories in the West, because he happens to be the highest in that Department! Every victory in the East is attributed to McClellan, because they happen under his official direction, although he has not smelt powder since his promotion. The glory is all given to the President, the Secretary of War or Navy, or some of their subordinates, because the real heroes have "reported" their deeds "through" them as their superior officers. Thus men out of danger, at Washington, would win all the renown by toil and danger upon battle-fields hundreds and thousands of miles away. How contemptible--how unjust, is the sublime impudence of "Red-Tapeism!"

Just now, there is a singular conspiracy to puff up McClellan. All the half-secession Editors in the North of late are deigningly eulogistic in praising him. To read their fulsome palaver, one would think there is no good Union officer but McClellan. Curtis, Dupont, Seigel, Foot, &c., are utterly ignored by these Rebel sympathizers, who (especially since the escape from Manassas) rank McClellan with Fabius, Hannibal, Washington, and--Napoleon even. The plaudits of this sort of patriots inflict an injury upon that officer, which we hope his deeds will yet amend; but his modesty and sense of justice should lead him--as they did Sec. Stanton--to publicly disavow all wishes to deprive brother officers of their due meed of praise.

Just look at it. Because DUPONT "reported" to the Secretary of the Navy, therefore Sec. WELLES is really the hero of Port Royal, is he? Because CURTIS, SEIGEL, ASBOTH, CURR, &c., at Pea Ridge, "reported" to Halleck, and Halleck "reported" to McClellan, and McClellan "reported" to Stanton, and Stanton "reported" to the President, therefore Lincoln and Stanton and McClellan and Halleck are the true warrior-victors in Arkansas, and Curtis and Seigel are only "Abolition fanatics," are they?

Privates and all non-commissioned officers are heard "through" Captains and other officers of higher grade who "report" to Colonels, who "report" to Brigadiers, who "report" to Generals of Divisions, who "report" to Commanders of Departments, who "report" to the Senior Major General at Washington (when there is one there), who "reports" to the Secretary of War, who "reports" to the President. These are regular gradations in rank--and as the Commander-in-Chief is highest of all, GENERAL LINCOLN is entitled--according to the logic of McClellan's panegyrics--to the glory of all the Union victories on Land and Sea--a preposterous absurdity. We might just as well attribute to either of the two men all our defeats.

The MEN REPORTING, and not those REPORTED TO, are the true heroes, or the ones disgraced, in wars. Those who PLAN well, are entitled to credit for that, but the FIGHTING is the most important. The best Plans may fail for want of good Fighters--but good soldiers may do and amend mistakes of their superiors.

The President and his Cabinet--Scott and McClellan--doubtless, matured wisely, months ago, expeditions that have since explained themselves, generally, to satisfaction. But their subordinates had the REAL WORK to do. The President and Cabinet, in their comfortable seats at Washington, direct McClellan, who directs Halleck, who directs Curtis' troops to clean out South-Western Missouri of the Rebels. At that distance, they must act for themselves, as emergencies arise--and Halleck, thro' whom Curtis "reported," is no more a hero of Pea Ridge, than is Sec. Stanton.
