Last week, our two patriotic workmen, Samuel L. Beck, Jr., and Walter M'Mahon, left us to try "shooting sticks" that have balls in them. We wish them all success. But it leaves us short-handed, and the labor and excitement of the times have prevented us from issuing more than half a sheet this week, and we may only issue one next week.

Last Saturday morning, under the Governor's call for State defense, Capt. Shorkley started for Harrisburg with some 70 men, who were followed on Monday morning by about 30 more, under R. H. Chamberlain, principally from the South Ward, Lewisburg.

Saturday evening, Capt. Forrest and Lieut. Dill, started with about 40 men, and Monday morning Lieut. Rice started with 30 or 40 more, chiefly from the North Ward, Lewisburg.

At Harrisburg, these companies occupied the Senate Chamber, and were sent forward to Chambersburg, and we hear, since, to Greencastle, on the State Line, not far from Hagerstown. Our latest statement is, that after taking the vote by Companies, all our Companies agreed to move on to Hagerstown, where they probably now are.

We give a part of Shorkley's Company—all we have received as yet.

The Regiment was organized by choosing Wm. Dorris, of Huntingdon, Colonel. W. C. Lawson, of Milton, Lieut. Col. Wm. Erick, of Chester, Major. J. R. Loomis, of Lewisburg, Chaplain. These Companies are now doubtless drilling, and may or may not soon be discharged—all depending upon the success of our army on the Potomac.

John A. Ettinger, of New Berlin, offered a squad of 40, and Wm. F. Wilson, of Harrisburg, a squad of 15, for the State service, but they could not be accepted under the regulations.

BEER! BEER!—While Pennsylvania is importing her sons to step mere factious strife and rush to arms to save our soil from the pollution of Rebel feet, Wm. H. Miller, of Harrisburg, is inaugurating a series of excitements, by partizan harangues in this Congressional district, to elect him to an Office! Office! He does not tell his Democratic friends to *exit*, and save the country—not a word of that; but he denounces the Administration, and (privately) tells Democrats to *stay at home and vote*. So say reports of his meetings in Snyder county, last week. Many honest Democrats disregard his example and advice, but we are assured they are followed by a majority of his party.

One Thousand Men—a full Regiment—from our small county! This is almost one out of every two men liable to do duty! Can any county in the State show a greater devotion to the cause? Heaven grant that it may not all be in vain—but that the sacrifices made may avail in bringing the blessings of Peace and Liberty over all our land!

With a thousand of the men of our county impelling their lives for the sustenance of the Government of our fathers, there are also men banded together for the purpose of breaking down the Administration which is breasting the torrent of sedition, robbery and bloodshed commenced by the Rebels! Can men be friends of their country who strike hands with its open enemies to crush its Administration? Men who vote against supplies to our brave soldiers, and advocate yielding to Rebels whose hands are dyed in the best blood of our brothers and fellow citizens, may be honest, but they are cruelly and blindly unwise.

FOUR HUNDRED MEN!—With 192 men credited, 25 or 30 not credited but in service, and those since enlisted in Shorkley's, Forrest's, and Hayes' Companies, the Borough of Lewisburg now has doubtless *Four Hundred Men* engaged in active service against the Slavery Rebellion. This is far more than half our men liable to or capable of military duty—nearly our usual number of voters! Can any town—outside of Kansas—show a more hearty, unselfish devotion to the cause?

Court has been very largely attended this week. The principal trial was Commonweal vs. Lineweaver of Lebanon, indicted for conspiracy in marrying a girl in her teens without her parents' knowledge and consent. After being out all night, the Jury this morning brought in a verdict of acquittal—each party to pay half the costs.

Notwithstanding the absence of one or two Teachers, the University at Lewisburg will re-open, next week. Mr. Randolph is in the North Ward Company, but intends to open the Academy, 1st October.

Maj. Joel B. Wanner, Mayor of Reading, now in the Union Army, is nominated for Congress, against Aucona, who voted with Vallandigham. Wanner is a Union Democrat.

The Hon. Joseph Holt, of Kentucky, has been appointed Judge Advocate General, an office created at the last Session of Congress.

ANNUAL REPORT.

The Committee of Publication of the University of Lewisburg, having attended with pleasure the Commencement Exercises for the year 1862, would state that there graduated, this year, 265 male students, from the several departments, viz: 1 from the Theological, 10 from the College, and 19 from the Female Institute. Their departments as far as your Committee are aware, has been respectable, and their attainments promise to be so.

Both last and the last year, visited the University paper, but three of its Alumni have been transferred to their last abode. Rev. John Q. A. Roberts, the first Foreign Missionary from this University, is supposed to have been lost on his journey to Japan. Rev. Washington Bardsley, of the first graduating class, and Edward W. Moore, perished amidst the trials of the intestine war in South-Western Missouri.

The Board of Instruction remains unchanged, except that two much esteemed members in the Institute, resigned on account of ill health; a committee is deputed to supply their places. Prof. Tustin was prostrated with sickness near the close of the term, but now recovered. With these exceptions, general health has been enjoyed.

Wm. T. Brantley having voluntarily left the loyal States and united his fortunes with the enemies of our country, his seat was vacated in the Board of Trustees.

Rev. Messrs. Randall and Hanson of Philadelphia, visited New York at Wood of Harrisburg, were admitted to the Board of Trustees. After having served two years, Mr. Worden requested to be relieved from duty as Scriber, and Rev. S. H. Mirick was chosen in his stead.

In the Academic Department, the rules requiring students not admitted to board in common is so far modified that the President has discretionary power to allow the more advanced or older to board elsewhere.

The property of the University is valued at \$135,000. Yet, with all its endowments, the receipts from tuition are not sufficient to meet the yearly expenses.

The excitement of the times, doubtless, has drawn away many from the halls of learning to the battle field.

To keep pace with other institutions, and to place ours in the front rank contemplated, more exertion is required.

Anxious to advance the interests of the University, the Trustees have reappointed a Financial Agent. Should circumstances justify him in undertaking labor at present, it is hoped he will be encouraged and rewarded "for his work's sake."

An increasing desire has been manifested for the appointment of a competent Professor of Belles Lettres or English Literature. It is true, many other Colleges are deficient in this respect. Yet, in our age and country, the ability to speak and write our mother tongue with elegance and force is deemed by many the most important practical part of a liberal education. The Alumni, with true filial love, this year recommended such a chair of instruction, and opened a subscription in its behalf. The Curators also officially pledged their cooperation. And the Trustees, desirous of responding to this urgent wish for a fresh impetus to the University by furnishing new advantages, have appointed a committee to nominate some one to impart the desired instruction, and appointed for a temporary trial of such person. The importance of the matter justifies caution.

Your Committee are constrained again to report, that to make this institution properly effective with the people who remain in it, chiefly, many more pupils should be in attendance. Ample rooms and qualified teachers invite them. Its exact patronage has been reasonably good, but its DISCIPLINARY PATRONAGE decidedly deficient. Whole Churches and Associations are unrepresented in an Institution which nearly all contribute, and where all feel a *personal* interest. The receipts from tuition might be largely increased without any considerable additional expense.

It would be very easy for almost every Church, in Pennsylvania and that part of New Jersey sympathizing with us, to join and send one or more to some department of the University, year by year. Surely there are youth, in all those communities, who, in the use of light, knowledge and process, should receive the most efficient course of education, and then take up the banner of freedom.
