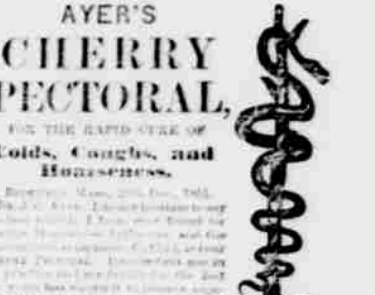

THE VICKSBURG CUT-OFF. The sagacious plan adopted by Brig. Gen. Williams last fall of cutting off Vicksburg, from the banks of the Mississippi, by making a diversion in the channel of that river, appears likely to be carried out most effectually by the operations of nature.
