Freedom of the Press.

NEW YORK, June 8 .- At a meeting editors, to-day, Horace Greeley, of Tribune, was Chairman, and 16 oth were present. Resolutions were adop to the effect that we recognize and aff the duty of fidelity to the Constitution the Government and laws of our countr that treason and rebellion are crimes ; th while we emphatically disclaim and deny any right as inhering to journalists to incite, advocate, abet, uphold or justify treason or rebellion, we respectfully but firmly assert the right of the press to criticise freely and fearlessly the acts of those charged with the administration of the Government, and of their civil and military subordinates, and that any limitations of this right, created by the necessities of war, should be confined to the localities where bostilities exist or are immediately threatened. Also, that military commanders should not exercise the power

of declaring what are treasonable papers. This important declaration, concurred

in by all the daily journals except the Satanie Herald, and the Copperhead World, which, instead of attempting rightly to agree upon what restrictions war


