ANOTHER STEP IN ADVANCE.—The Emperor, Alexander II., Tsar of Russia, having completed the liberation of thirty million serfs in Russia, has recently performed another act that will add increasing lustre to the glory of his reign. He has issued a decree, that on April 15, every serf in Poland should be set free from bondage, allowing him to own the cottage and plot of ground he has been occupying, to have his time and labor for his own, and to be liberated from all claims to service and obligations to labor which his master may have possessed over him. The peasants are also at once to become self-governing citizens, being allowed to elect their own local authorities. The Polish aristocracy, while agitating Europe for the purpose of securing liberty for themselves, have never shown a disposition to give freedom to their serfs, who have thus obtained it from the Autocrat himself.

MUHAMMEDIAN TOLERATION TO JEWS.—Sir Moses Montefiore, a wealthy and benevolent English Jew, has recently been on an embassy to the Sultan of Morocco in behalf of the Jews in that empire, who have suffered great grievances on account of their religion. He was most cordially welcomed, and hospitably entertained in the Sultan's palace. He graciously received the petition of Sir Moses, and four days after, on February 5, issued an edict for equal and impartial justice to his Jewish subjects. It says, "It is our command that all Jews residing within our dominions, be the condition in which the Almighty God has placed them whatever it may, shall be treated by our governors, administrators, and all other subjects in a manner conformable with the evenly balanced scales of justice; and that in the administration of the courts of law the Jews shall occupy a position of perfect equality with all other people."
