The House bill was struck out entirely, and a new one inserted, giving to the Court power to vacate letters of administration and the appointment of executors, guardians, and other trustees, in cases where sickness prevents the appointee from filling his trust, and to appoint others in place of those named.

Senate bill supplementary to the several acts relative to the State Insane Hospital. It gives the Court power to secure summary into the alleged insanity of any person about to be sent to the Hospital, and to give the Director power to recover the costs of maintaining indigent insane persons in the Hospital, from the township or district on which they are a proper charge.
