We are able to state authoritatively that our  
Sister, Mr. Ensign, has neither sought nor re-  
ceived an appointment at Washington, as has  
been stated by several of the city papers. And

4 cents per letter weighing not more  
than half an ounce, for any distance not ex-  
ceeding five hundred miles, and 6 cents ad-  
ditional for every half ounce or fraction of an  
ounce.

Advertisement letters will be charged two  
cents in addition to the regular postage.

Drop letters, and letters placed in the office for  
delivery only, will be charged two cents ad-  
ditional.

Letters sent to agents of the Postmaster General  
will be charged one cent.

Postage weekly newspapers within the Con-  
federate States will be charged one cent.

Postage twice weekly newspapers will be charged  
two cents per issue.

Postage monthly newspapers will be charged  
three cents per issue.
