From the recent census report in Canada, Lutheranism has prospered in this province. It has increased from 12,107, in 1882, to 25,119 in 1901. This more than doubling in nine years. The principal portion of this number live in Upper Canada, there being scarcely one thousand in Lower Canada.

Several of the Lutheran Synods, principally in the West and North-west, believe, have been called Synodical Conventions, with strictly practical and different session settlements in a given circuit. The plan is found to work well, and the Lutheran and Missionary, advises all the synods to have one or more such synods employed in their respective bounds to do this important work.

The United Presbyterian suggests the holding of a convention in Pittsburgh, or Allegheny, the week, or the few days of the same week, before the meeting of the Assembly, of a similar character to the convention for conference and prayer, held in Xenia, Ohio, four years ago. It says the results of that meeting were most happy.

After speaking of the benefits to be derived from such a meeting, reference is then made to the important services being held at Xenia. The Book of Government, the Directory for Worship, and the amended version of the Psalms are matters which involve the deepest interests.
