Washington, May 25.—The city has been filled with exciting rumors all day in regard to the fate of the remnant of Gen. Banks' column, left in the vicinity of Strasburg.

After three-fifthe of his army had been sent-to reinforce Gen. McDowell from the supposed approach of the robel forces under Jackson and Ewell at Fredericksburg, it appears now that the supposition of Gen. McDowell, that Jackson and Ewell were pressing upon his front, was incorrect, and that at the very moment when he called for these reinforcements these robel Generals were still hovering about Gen.
