The Hon. Wm. A. Graham also made a very able speech in favor of this tax, as did Mesers. Badger, Bagley, Barns, Brown, Donnell, Foster, Holden, Leak (of Anson) Satter-thwaite, Warren, and many others. Mr. Graham said: "The gentleman from Hartford (Mr. Rayner) accuses this Convention of incompetency for the duty of revising the Constitution. The gentleman from Rowan (Mr. Junes) asserts that it has fallen into distavor with the people, and therefore they both concur in its adjournment or dissolution.
