To enable this to be done it is asserted that Gen. Halleck will be put in command, with the understanding that he will remain in Washingten. This will relieve the President and Mr. Stanton from attacks in the future, on the ground that they have improperly interfered with this or that General. This is rumor. UST PUBLISHED The following is the resolution which has passed both Houses, and which removes the President's objection to the Confiscation set:

\*Resolved\*, By the Senate and Heuse of Representatives, etc., that the provisions of the third clause of the fifth section of an act to suppress insurrection, to punish treason and rebellion, to seize and confiscate the property of rebels, and for other purposes, shall be construed as not to apply to any act or act done prior to the passage thereof, nor to include any member of a state legislature or judge of any state court who has not, in accompling or entering upon his office, taken an oath to, support the Constitution of the so-coalled Confederate States of America; nor to Helping upon his office, taken an oath to, support the Constitution of the so-coalled Confederate States of America; nor said act be so construed as to work a forfield state of the real estate of the offender beyond his natural Hife.
