After receiving the brief account of such a sanguinary engagement as that which formed the subject of Gen. Fox's dispatch to Gen. Halleck, and which was evidently to be but one of a series of desperate conflicts to follow...

The effect will be further developed as time goes on, in opening a way for that service which, if it shall be permitted to come, will produce indeed a feeling throughout the world, and can only at last result in an entirely new system of trade and commerce between the United States and all foreign nations.

It is not necessary that these views are not grounded on any proceedings or expressions of the British Government, and are to be submitted to them only, as they will be to the other States from a similar position on the part of the President that the true condition of the present strife may be everywhere fully understood.

From all this we infer that Mr. Seward deems the slavery question one of vast position in the hands of the Government, and by withholding this power it can at any time to cripple the rebel arms to render further resistance on their part abortive; that a general act of emancipation would most probably lead to serious insurrection, and the complete destruction of Southern society and industrial interests.

I am aware that in regard to this point I am opening a subject which was early interdicted in this correspondence. The reason for the interdictum is obvious. But that the operation of a cause peculiar to the Government, and not to the rebel, is being forward—mean the practice of African Slavery.

The region where the insurrection still remains a latent capacity may be destroyed, and a negro population of 5,000,000 chiefly slaves, it is thus seen to be between two parties of the white race, not only in the present, but in the very midst of the conflict, and the very fact of its existence would not be overlooked.
