Another Rebel Raid in Western Virginia. On Saturday night, dispatches were received by Adjutant General Samuels, from reliable sources, stating that two bodies of rebel cavalry, under the command of Gen. Lee, had taken Buchanan and Weston, and were en route for Clarkburg. Orders were immediately issued for the arming and marching of the Twelfth Regiment to the scene of the operations of the rebels. All night the General and his assistants, as well as the officers of the Twelfth, were engaged in preparing to meet the rebels. Early this morning they were dispatched as rapidly as possible, every exertion possible being made to complete their equipment. They were marched to the depot of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad, and there with the baggage of the Twelfth, they were loaded on the cars.
