Capts, Grant and Anderson, with a small party of infantry and cavalry, were attacked by 250 savages, 18 miles from Fort Ridgely. During the angagement the whites managed to throw up breastworks of dead horses and earthy and held out until Bibley came to their relief, and drove the Indians back. Thirteen whites were killed and forty-seven wounded; most of the killed are from St. Panl. Before the engagement Capt. Grant's party buried eighty-five of the massicared. One woman had laid in the woods two weeks unburied.
