But Frederickshurg is an excellent point for a supply depot, because we can use the Potomae and Rappahannock rivers for the transportation of supplies all the winter through, assisted by the tailroad frem Acquia Creek. Again, the difficulty of waging war in Virginia renders it necessary that a large army in active operation should be instantly connected with its supply depot by a railroad, and this will be found leading from Frederickshurg all the way to Richmond. Two days' march along this road will bring our army to a point where it can obtain supplies from points on the Warw, York, James, and Rappahannock rivers. Three or four days' march from Frederickshurg will bring us in front of Richmond again, and give the Army of the Potomae a reinforcement of 50,000 men, besides wooden and iron-clad gunboats in soundance.
