

CITY AFFAIRS.

THE COMMON GROUNDS OF ALLEGANY
—Interesting Decision.
Ever since the present system of grading and paving streets in the City of Allegheny at the expense of the property abutting on the improved streets, a question has existed whether the burden of the expense should fall on the owner of the property or on the city. The common grounds of Allegheny have been the center of this question, and the Street Commissioners of that city have recently secured a decision from the Supreme Court in their favor.

The case arose from a dispute over the cost of grading and paving the streets of Allegheny, which had been sold to the city by the common grounds company. The city claimed that the property owners should bear the cost of improvements made to the streets in front of their property, while the common grounds company maintained that the city was responsible for such expenses.

The Supreme Court, in its decision, ruled in favor of the city, holding that the improvements were made to the streets in the public interest and that the burden of the cost should fall on the city rather than on the individual property owners. This decision is expected to resolve similar disputes in other cities.
