CROP PROSPECT FOR 1862.

ISAAC NEWTON, Esq., Commissioner of Agriculture, has just issued the following important statement, presenting a short abstract of the returns to the Agricultural Department of the amount and condition of the crops in May, 1862.

In explanation of the table, it is only necessary to say, that the number 10 represents an average of the crops, both as to their amount compared with the crops of 1862, and their appearance in May, 1862. A number above or below 10, represents as many tenths as it is above or below 11. Thus 12 is two tenths below an average, and 14 is four tenths below it.
