They captured these without much difficulty, tied them up hands and feet and left them at a cotton gin near by, tailing them to stay there till they (the rabels) returned. While the darkies were standing status-like, against a ferse, one of them discovered that the cord by which his hands were fastened was poorly tied, and without much difficulty he loosed his hempen fetters. His next work was to set his commace free, and in less than an hour after their capture the pickets were taking a directions route to empty where they arrived ahead of the rebel column, and in time to give raluable information as to the number of rebels engaged in the attack. They brought their arms and cartridge-borse with them, having found them where the rebels had left them in the cotton-gin.
